This year's camps...

Kids Camps-ages 3-6 years old, 7-9 years old

Our weekly themed camps focus on Dancing, Singing, Acting, Crafts and Games. All activities are designed for both boys and girls ages 3-6 & 7-9 (two groups) and will include a performance at 11:30 on the final day, for the parents and family. Our themes this year are “Frozen”, “Angry Birds” and Super Heroes.

Writing and Directing-ages 12 and up

This camp focuses on play writing with minor focus on other components necessary to produce a play. The student will learn how to develop a storyline (plot), character build, conflict, climax and technique on writing dialog. Because it's important to understand the workings of stage theater, they will also learn what is possible on stage, how to work with a producer, director and use of props. Each student will have an opportunity to present his/her written play and each will have the opportunity to work with another writer to direct a play.

Art Camp-ages 7-10, 11 and up

Come and learn different styles of art from painting to abstract to color wheel and blending. We will have a new project every day of the week with an art gallery for parents to view on the final day of camp. Art show begins Friday, July 22nd at 11:30. *There will be an additional \$30.00 supply fee per student, painting t-shirt provided.*

Dance Combo-ages 7 and up, Intermediate to Advanced levels

This camp will focus on learning 4-5 styles of intermediate to advanced dances from Lyrical, Jazz, to Hip Hop. You will also learn the National Dance Day Routine from the popular show “So You Think You can Dance” and the “Dizzy Feet Foundation. Our videoed performance will be Saturday, July 30th at 9:00 am. World Dance-ages 7 and up, Beginning to Intermediate levels

We will visit 4 beautiful cultures, learn a dance and explore their rich history. We will be learning a Mexican Folk piece, Hawaiian Hula, American Barn Dance and an Irish Dance. Our performance Friday, August 12th at 11:30am, each student will have an opportunity to explain to our audience the history and facts of the dance they will be performing.

Costume and Make up camp-ages 7-10, and 11 and up

We will learn how to apply stage make up from “aged” to “animal”. How to apply and how to achieve the different looks you might find on stage. We will also learn how to choose costumes appropriate for those make up looks with costume pieces from our own costume selection.

There will be an additional \$30.00 supply fee per student which will include a small picture book with photos of the students looks

*Amateur Hour 3

Each year SALT invites students' ages 8-11, 12 and up to participate in a short summer program designed with creative fun as the number one priority. As they go through the program, each student has opportunity to showcase their individual talents in any or all elements of performance - singing, dancing, and theater. The students are invited to come with their own material to be evaluated and in most cases performed. Not all students wish to come with their own material so the students suggest fun ideas during the first session. Material is developed by those in the class and/or provided by the directors. At the end, the entire class performs a high energy and mini-spectacular variety show that has been one of the highlights of the summer. The Amateur Hour performance has become a SALT tradition, kicking off the new school year with a bang. Admission is free to our performance, Friday August 26th at 6:00 pm.

Cost is \$50.00 per performer.

*Audition Workshop

Have you ever wondered what the judges' panel is looking for during open auditions? Now is your chance to learn some valuable information and techniques on how to present your skills and talent in the best light. This one day camp will focus on vocal presentation, song choice, how to catch the judge's attention, how to find and present a monologue, film and commercial auditions and how to make sure you know what the judges are looking for in an actor, singer or dancer. Stage presence and command of an audience (especially judges) is critical so if you want to improve your audition presence, this camp is for you!

*SALT PAC (Salt Performing Arts Company)

SALT PAC is the elite performing group for SALT. They are chosen by audition on how well they perform material given to them during SALT PAC Week. SALT holds a week long high intensity (some lovingly say "grueling") camp for those who are interested and then on Friday night, auditions are held to choose the new members. Much is required of our SALT PAC members, including being the face of SALT to the community by performing during the year and volunteering to assist in SALT programs. To become a SALT PAC member, a performer must demonstrate abilities in 2 of the 3 performing arts areas, Singing, Dancing and/or Theater (Drama/Comedy) and have a high level of commitment to the program. In one week the "newbies" will learn a full musical theater number, monologue, solo, group comedy skit, hip hop dance and how to work under pressure. The camp is open to ages 12 and up. Camp will run Monday-Friday 9am-1pm with auditions Friday, August 5th at 6pm. Space will be limited so sign up quickly!

Cost is \$150 per student.
